Follow up questions

- What causes the white bubbly water that goes to the river? (**Asa jud gikan ang puti na tubig na mag buwa2 na mo dung sa sapa**)
i.e. If gikan sa ila linabhan, chemicals sa mga factories
- How many noted incidents of polio? (**Pila ang inyo na ilhan ang naka kuha nag polio**)
- Do they experience any type of water problems? (**Naa ba sila na agi-an na mga problema sa tubig**)
- Describe the water condition around 2008? The smell, the color, etc (**Unsa ang ila ma ingon sa tubig sa sapa pag 2008? Unsay baho, unsay nawng, unsay kolor, etc**)
- Around what year did the GLR cement company have effects on the condition of the river? (**Mga unsa tuiga nakakita mo na naka epekto ang hugaw na tubig sa GLR cement sa sapa**)
- Economically, are they affected? (**Naka epekto ba ang pagka hugaw sa river sa ila ekonomiya**)
- If the people nearer to the river get sicker easier? (**Mas daghan ba og mga nasakit na tao na nag puyo duol sa sapa**)
- If they were supported by the government would they try to fix their houses that was destroyed in the flood?
- During the flood that happened 2 years ago how fast did the flood rise and how fast did it go down? (**Katong baha na nahitabo kato duha katuiga, unsa ka paspas ni saka ang baha og unsa sad siya ka paspas ni ubos**)
- Is the stream flow in the river fast or slow? (**Ang dagan sa tubig adtos sapa pas2 ba siya or hinay?**) (Follow up Qs: Naa ba year na pas2 siya or karun raba na na hinay siya)
- How do you describe the smell in the area? (**Para ninyo unsay maingon ninyo sa baho sa ila lugar**) (Follow up Qs: Gikan bana sa sapa or sa mga basura or both?)
- How are they affected by the heat, especially since their homes are made out of wood? (**Unsay ma ingon nila na epekto sa init sa ila balay samot nag mga kahoy ila balay**)
- How often do crimes occur in their community? (**Kasagaran ba na naay krimen sa inyo lugar?**)



- How is the electricity in the area? (Kumusta man ang kuryente sa inyo lugar) (Follow up Os: Source)
- Are their employment opportunities limited? (Gamay raba ila mga oportunidad na maka kuha og trabaho)
- What are their income sources? (Asa mo nagkuha sa inyo mga kita?)
- What are your jobs? (Unsa inyo mga trabaho?)
- Are you offered any health services? (Naa bamo mga health service aria?)
- What are the common health illnesses? (if it came from the river) (Unsay mga kommon na mga sakit diri lugara? Gikan bani siyas sapa?)
- What are the common languages that they speak? (Unsay inyo mga pinulongan aria lugara)
- What are their religion? (Unsa ila mga relihiyon adto lugara)
- Are they educated? (Naka skwela raba sila?) (Follow up Qs: What was their highest educational attainment?)
- How close are they with each other? (Unsa sila ka suod sa ila adto na lugar)
- How often do they play sports? (Mag sige bag silag duwa og mga sports didto ila)
- Do they have festivals or celebrations in their area? (Naa ba sila mga fiesta didto lugara)
- What can we do to motivate them? (Unsa ato mahimo para ma motivate sila na mo lihok sad bahin sa pag tabang limpyo sa ila sapa)
- When you noticed that many people are throwing their trash in the river? What have you done to prevent people from dumping their trash there? (Kato nakabantay mo daghan2 na ang mga tao na nag labay sa ila basura sa sapa? Unsa inyo ge himo para di mo gara ang mga tao labay didto?)

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Maud Schurmans's Inquiries

Aim of the River Scan Challenge

(Zeldrick Tutor)

"to investigate and help find innovative, ingenious, and implementable solutions to the current problems that the two cities are experiencing in terms of water supply shortage,



water quality issues due to pollution and discharge of untreated effluents, and solid waste mismanagement”

- What is the aim? (unsay tuyo ani sa program)
- to investigate the river condition (mag-imbestiga sa sitwasyon sa suba):
 - Measure parameters of water (magsukod ug mga paremetro sa tubig)
 - Unsay chemical naa. unsa ka daghana, ug unsa ilang epekto
 - E.g. acidity (unsa ka acidic), turbidity (unsa ka tin-aw)
 - Dili namo na role (sa mga expert na na)
 - Survey the residents (mangutana mi sa mga lumulopyo)
 - Among tan-awn kung unsa gyuy kahimtang dani dapita
 - Unsay mga problema
 - Unsay mga hinungdan sa mga problema, nganong ngana mana?
- And to help find innovative, indigenous and implementable solutions to the problems (mutabang mi ug pangita ug mga bag-ong solusyon gikan sa komunidad nga ma mapatuman nato)
 - Sa mga problema sa supply sa tubig, kalidad sa tubig tungod sa polusyon, Ug mga pagpataka nga paglabay sa mga hugaw ug basura
